Name of the author is written in the upper right corner in bold italics. It is necessary to specify organization. Further on, the title of the work is printed in the middle, in capital letters in bold type without abbreviations. Abstract (2-4 sentences) and key words are afterwards.

Paginal automatic footnotes, by the numbers (size 12). Paragraph (red line) - 1.25 cm (don't use the "Space"). Automatic hyphenation. References are listed alphabetically at the end of the article. The file should have the name of the author.
