UArctic Annual Report for 2023

UArctic continued to move forward on key strategic priorities in 2023, with a significant focus on strengthening leadership and administrative capacity in the areas of research, philanthropic fundraising, and Indigenous issues.

Planning continued for the Arctic Congress Bodø 2024, being hosted by Nord University and the Nordland Research Institute, in partnership with the International Arctic Social Sciences Association (IASSA) and High North Dialogue. The calls for both sessions and abstracts resulted in record numbers of submissions with nearly 140 total sessions moving ahead. The acceptance of abstracts, final program, and meeting registration will be ready in mid-March 2024. https://www.arcticcongress.com/

The External Evaluation Committee concluded its work and presented its recommendations to the Board and leadership of UArctic. A response plan to these findings is on the agenda for the beginning of 2024 in time to be presented to the Assembly meeting in Bodø.

The 2023 UArctic Rectors Meeting was held at the Oceanographic Institute in Monaco on January 12-13, 2023, in partnership with the Prince Albert I of Monaco Foundation and the University of Versailles Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines.

A new UArctic research program on Arctic maritime safety was launched with a scoping seminar in Iceland in October. Supported by Lloyd's Register Foundation Heritage and Education Centre, the program will look into historical perspectives on current safety challenges in the Arctic ocean economy, and learn from the past to help address today's challenges to the safety of peoples in the Arctic. It aims to deliver new insights, evidence, and case materials to policy and change makers, and also highlight further opportunities for collaboration. The program will be implemented through cross-disciplinary research fellowships and outreach.

The third Frederik Paulsen Arctic Academic Action Award was awarded to Minik Thorleif Rosing at the Arctic Circle Assembly in Iceland in October. His initiative proposes to use glacial rock flour to reduce atmospheric carbon dioxide (CO2) concentrations, improve global food security, and bring new business opportunities to Greenland.

The Board held meetings online in March as well as in person meetings in Bergen, Norway (April) and Alaska, USA (November). Key issues on the Board agenda included strategic fundraising priorities and frameworks such as the UArctic Foundation (US), finance model, and membership

growth strategy. Considerable attention was also given to developing operational guidelines which are required for project work with private foundations and other funders. The Board also reviewed UArctic's ongoing policy to pause the Russian members. The existing policy was confirmed, with no formal institutional collaboration but allowing for individual researchers to work with Thematic Networks where possible.

The UArctic Assembly was held in Quebec City, hosted by Université Laval, from 22-26 May, 2024. Highlights of the meeting included a video address from Canada's Governor General, the Right Honorable Mary Simon, who is also one of UArctic's Founders. The Assembly elected Dr. Lesley Brown (Yukon University) and Viljo Vuorimäki (student representative, University of Lapland) as members of the Board for terms 2023-2026.

During the meeting, UArctic welcomed 17 new members: Keyano College, Ontario Tech University, University of Alaska Southeast, University of Toronto, World Maritime University, Global Health - McMaster University, Arctic Initiative - Belfer Center of the Harvard Kennedy School, Science Diplomacy Center, Indian Maritime University Jilin University, Rashtriya Raksha University, University of Dundee, University of Glasgow, University of Tasmania, Arctic Basecamp Foundation, Halpin Research Centre, and Oxford University Polar Forum.

Four Thematic Networks that had provisional status from 2022 were given final approval: Decolonization of Arctic Library and Archives Metadata (DALAM), Digital North: Three-Dimensional Technologies and Arctic Education, Frozen Arctic Conservation, Northern and Arctic Island Studies Research. The Assembly also provisionally approved five new networks: Arctic Cultures and History, Blue Economy and the Arctic, Collaborative Online International Learning and Biodiversity Education across the Arctic Circle (COIL@UArctic), High Latitude Dust, and Microtomography of Arctic Marine Organisms.

Full summary of the Assembly programs and decisions

New leadership and administrative capacity was put in place with the appointment of Morgan Dulian as Executive Director of Development, and Dustin Bawcom as Project and Office Manager supporting philanthropic fundraising. Both are based in Fairbanks, Alaska. Gunnar Stefánsson was appointed as UArctic's new VP Research, supported by staff with him at the University of Iceland. Rickard Danel of Umeå University was named as Associate VP Research Analytics. Finally, Nadia (Gàgala-λiλətko) Joe of Yukon University became UArctic's new VP Indigenous, including administrative support.

There were 21 UArctic Chairs in 2023, who continue to be very active in research, education, and outreach across their profile areas, as well as providing key consultative inputs to UArctic's operations. The Chairs also work closely with UArctic's 60 Thematic Networks. The Thematic Networks leads had their annual meeting at the Arctic Centre in Rovaniemi, hosted by the University of Lapland, Rovaniemi, Finland on April 25-27, 2023.

North2north mobility is also returning to pre-pandemic numbers with 149 exchanges during the year.


